

Explore an enchanting adventure to discover the rich, diverse, astounding landscapes of Nepal with its most essential destinations Pokhara, and a jungle safari in Chitwan National Park in the southern lowlands of Nepal.

DAY 01: ARRIVE KATHMANDU

Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu (Nepal). Meeting & assistance on arrival and transfer to the hotel. Check in at the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Evening, have a relaxed first meal in Thamel – the lively tourist hub of the city. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 02: KATHMANDU

After Breakfast, half day sightseeing of Kathmandu City visiting Hanuman Dhoka (It is the historic seat of Royalty. The Durbar Square with its old temples & Palaces epitomizes the religious & cultural life of the people. It is here that kings of Nepal are crowned & their coronations solemnized. Interesting things to see here are Taleju Temple built by King Mahendra Malla in 1549 AD, Kal Bhairav,), Temple of living Goddess (The temple residence of living goddess, Kumari, is situated in vicinity of Hanuman Dhoka Palace. The building has been profusely carved with wooden balconies & window screens. The Kumari- The Living Goddess, acknowledges the greetings from her Balcony window) and Swayambunath (This is one of the world's most glorious Buddhist Chaityas. It is said to be 2000 Yrs. old. Painted on the four sides of the spire bases are the all-seeing eyes of lord Buddha).

Visit Bhaktapur City (Situated at an altitude of 1,401 mtrs. Bhaktapur covers an area of 4 Sq. Miles. Shaped like a conch- shell), Boudhnath Stupa (This Stupa lies Eight Kms. East of Kathmandu. This colossal and ancient Stupa is one of the biggest in the world) and Pashupatinath Temple (Situated Five Kms. East of Kathmandu, the temple of lord Shiva- Pashupatinath with two-tiered golden roof and silver doors is famous for its superb architecture. Visitors can clearly see the temple and the activities performed in the temple premises from Eastern Bank of the Bagmati River). Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 03: KATHMANDU - POKHARA (BY AIR - ASTAM (25 KMS - 01 HR)

After breakfast, checkout from the hotel and transfer to the airport for flight to Pokhara – Nepal.

This is a short, less than an hour-long flight with great views of Annapurna and other Himalayan peaks. Upon arriving in Pokhara, drive to Astam and upon arrival at Astam, check in at the hotel.

AAstam is the place where stay is provided at a gorgeous eco-lodge with close-up views of the Annapurna Himalaya. Time to relax and overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 04: ASTRAM - POKHARA (80 KMS - 2½ HRS)

Enjoy the morning views or going for a short walk around Astam.

After breakfast, checkout from the hotel and drive to Pokhara. Upon arrival at Pokhara, check-in at the hotel. Time to explore the Lakeside area of the city. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 05: POKHAARA – CHITWAN (150 KMS – 3 HRS 30 MINUTES)

After breakfast, checkout from the hotel and drive to Chitwan National Park. Upon arrival at Chitwan, check-in at the hotel. Chitwan National Park is in the jungle of Southern Nepal, close to the Indian border. Chitwan may not be as well-known as the high mountains of Nepal, but it's a unique place that is worth a visit. Chitwan is home to one-horned rhinoceros, tigers and the narrow-snouted (gharial) crocodile.

Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.


DAY 06: CHITWAN

Today is a full day of jungle activities. Experience a walking jungle safari, birdwatching, jungle safaris on the back of an elephant or on the jeep and wildlife viewing.

Wildlife in Chitwan includes the greater one-horned rhinoceros, spotted deer, hog deer, sambar deer and barking deer as well as a wide variety of birdlife. With a bit of luck, there is always the chance of glimpsing the leopard, sloth bear and royal Bengal tiger. A favourite activity is always to visit the elephant camp and learn about these majestic animals, their habits and to have the opportunity to take part in bathing the elephant in the river. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 07: CHITWAN – KATHMANDU (175 KMS – 5 HRS)

After breakfast, checkout from the hotel and leave for Kathmandu by surface. Upon arrival at Kathmandu, check in to the hotel. Rest of the day at relax. Overnight stay at the hotel.
