

To take a fast glimpse of India, the Golden triangle is the most preferred tour. Northern India conjures up memorable and colourful images including Delhi, Agra and Jaipur. You will witness the fast-developing Capital of India- Delhi, the most romantic building in the World, The Taj Mahal, Fatehpur Sikri, the finest preserved deserted city in India and The Pink City of Jaipur, home to the wonderful former Maharaja Palace and splendid hilltop Amber Palace.

The Golden temple is located in the holy city of the Sikhs, Amritsar. The exquisite Golden temple is famous for its golden dome.

DAY 01: DELHI

Arrive at Delhi's Indira Gandhi International airport & meet our representative. Transfer to hotel. Check-in at the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: DELHI - JAIPUR (258 KMS - 41/2 HRS)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and leave for Jaipur by surface. Enroute visit Amber Fort – remarkable for the majestic grandeur of its surroundings as for its sturdy battlements and beautiful palaces. Climb up to the fort on the back of an Elephant or by jeep. Jaipur – the pink city of India. The capital of Rajasthan was given a colour coat of pink, a century ago in the honour of a visiting Prince, ever since it has retained the pink colour. Upon arrival at Jaipur, check-in at the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 03: JAIPUR

After breakfast, local city tour visiting City Palace - where the former Maharaja still resides in a part of it but rest now serves as a museum. Also visit Jantar Mantar, an observatory built by a great astronomer Sawai Jai Singh onto drive past through Hawa Mahal (Palace of winds). Afternoon, explore the colorful bazaars of Jaipur famous for Gemstone Jewelry, Paintings, block

prints, textiles, carpets, brassware, blue pottery etc. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 04: JAIPUR -FATEHPUR SIKRI - AGRA (242 KMS - 41/2 HRS)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and leave for Agra by surface, enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri – the deserted city of Emperor Akbar, which is still in a state of perfection. Upon arrival at Agra, check-in at the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 05: AGRA

After breakfast, sightseeing tour visiting the world-famous Taj Mahal built by Emperor Shah Jahan in 1630 in memory of his beloved wife, Queen Mumtaz, to enshire her Mortal remains. Visit Agra Fort built by Akbar reflecting the skills of the ancient Indian Architects. Visit Tomb of Itmad-ud-daullah, built by Empress Noorjehan in memory of her father. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 06: AGRA - DELHI (225 KMS - 31/2 HRS)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and leave for Delhi by surface. Upon arrival at Delhi, check in at the hotel. Afternoon, city tour of Old Delhi visiting Jama Masjid - the biggest Mosque in India and drive past Red Fort and tricycle tour of Chandani Chowk. Onto city tour of New Delhi. Drive past President House, Parliament House (House of Representatives) and India Gate - War Memorial (stop for photography), Qutab Minar - 72.55 meters, high Victory Tower, Humayun's Tomb - built of red sand-stone and is a first substantial example of the Mughal architecture. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 07: DELHI – AMRITSAR (BY AIR)

After breakfast, checkout from hotel and transfer to the airport for flight to Amritsar. Upon arrival at Amritsar, transfer to the hotel. Check-in at the hotel. Evening, visit the sacred shrine, Golden Temple and witness The Palki Sahib, a nightly ceremony venerating The Adi Granth as it carried in procession from the temple to the Akal Takt, seat of the Sikh Parliament. Golden Temple serves free meals over 100 thousand people every day. There are many volunteers who help to cook and serve the food to visitors. Golden Temple langar (Free eatery) is the biggest free eatery in the world. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 08: AMRITSAR


After breakfast, visit the historical place, Jalianwala Bagh where Britishers killed 2000 Indians who were gathering for a meeting in the year 1919. Onto Ram Bagh gardens, Khalsa Collage and the Hindu Durgiana Temple. Afternoon, drive to the Wagah border to witness the changing of the guards, an elaborate ceremony filled with pomp, circumstance, and national pride. Back to the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 09: AMRITSAR – DELHI (BY AIR)

Post breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport for flight to Delhi. Upon arrival at Delhi, transfer to hotel and check-in at the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 10: DELHI

Breakfast at the hotel. Day at leisure. Late check out from the hotel. Evening transfer to hotel near airport for dinner and then transfer to international airport to fly back home / onward destination.
